



## ***Pet Friendly Requirements***

We have made **ONE** of our Cottages “pet friendly” to allow guests to bring their special friends on holidays with them.

Please follow our simple rules so that we can continue to offer this to you and to future guests. Please do not just turn up with your pet expecting that it’s ok, we **MUST** confirm with you when making your booking that our pet friendly cottage (Mardi Cottage) is available on the dates you have requested.

For us to maintain the “pet friendly” cottage at our property the following rules **MUST** be adhered to please;

- 1 Please advise us at the time of booking if you have a furry friend travelling with you so we can confirm if ‘Mardi’ our pet friendly cottage is available.
- 2 We reserve the right to decline a booking if your pet details are not advised, or if it deemed that your pet would not be compatible with our farm layout and animals.
- 3 Your dog **MUST** be on a lead when walking around the property; they must not be allowed to roam freely around our paddocks which contain sheep, goats and their kids, alpacas and chickens etc.



- 4 Your dog can roam (supervised) down by the riverside with you however once back at the cottage area they need to be on a leash again.

- 5 Excessive barking will not be tolerated as it affects the peace & quiet of our other guests.
- 6 It is expected that you will clean up after your dog, same as you do in public places.
- 7 Your dog can go inside the cottage but must remain on the wooden floors. They must **NOT** get on the beds or lounge. Please bring sleeping items for your furry friend. The cottage offers a fenced & lockable covered verandah – the perfect place for them to unwind!
- 8 If it is evident that your dog has been on beds or lounge or has made a visible mess, an additional cleaning fee will be charged to your credit card.

Thank you for complying with our few simple rules; non-compliance can result in you being asked to leave.
